

*Klondike Lane Elementary
Uniform Guidelines*

Acceptable

Shirts (Any color – must be solid)

- **Solid** with collar (long or short sleeves).
- Oxford style shirts/blouses with collar (tie is optional and must be worn properly).
- Turtlenecks
- Undershirts, if worn, must be solid in color.
 - Pertains to any shirt visible underneath of the approved uniform shirt.
- Shirts **must** be tucked in at all times into pants, skirts, or shorts.
- Students will be permitted to wear a school purchased Klondike shirt with uniform pants on any day during the school week.
 - Klondike shirts must be tucked in at all times.

Pants/Shorts:

- Uniform style pants and shorts, navy, tan/khaki, or black (must button and zip).
- Capri Pants, navy, tan/khaki, or black.
- Shorts **must** be fingertip length and not below the knee.
- Pants must fit appropriately and contain no holes/tears.
 - Pants must be worn at waist level

Skirts/Skort/Jumpers

- **Must be** uniform style- solid color navy, tan/khaki, or black.
- **Must be** fingertip length or longer.
- Leggings, tights, or stockings must be a solid color and **must be** worn under clothing.
- Leggings, stocking, or tights may not be worn alone and must be worn underneath clothing.

Sweaters and Sweatshirts (Any color – must be solid)

- May wear Klondike sweatshirts and overhead sweaters.
- Solid color crew neck, sweater vest, cardigan, or v-neck.
- Sweaters and Sweatshirts **must be** worn with tucked in uniform shirt.
- Sweaters and Sweatshirts **must be** plain (Klondike Sweatshirts are acceptable).
- **No** hoods on sweatshirts/sweaters.

Shoes:

- Shoes with rubber soles or ballet flats.
- **Must be** closed toe and closed heel.
- Shoes **must be** appropriate for the activities of the school day. Safety is the prime consideration and shoes that impede safety should not be worn.
- Specialty shoes (i.e. wheels, web toes, lights, sandals, crocs, high heels, flip flops) are **not** allowed at school.
- Please be sure to wear well supported athletic shoes on days that students will be participating in physical education class.

Other Items:

- Students may not wear make-up or fake nails.
- No animal headbands (print is okay, no ears, etc.)

Coats/Outerwear:

Coats and jackets may not be worn in the building during the school day and **must be** stored in the locker or designated location in the classroom

Spirit-Day (Fridays only)

- Friday of each week will be designated as school spirit-day.
- This is a uniform day in which students will be allowed to wear jeans only if they wear a Klondike Lane Elementary shirt or sweatshirt (no hoodies).
- Student may also wear a school sponsored athletic uniform top or club shirt.
 - Basketball jerseys must have a shirt underneath
- Students must adhere to all uniform guidelines during spirit day.

Unacceptable:

- Pants **cannot** be denim, jeans, or sweat pants.
- Leggings **cannot** be worn as pants.
- Skirts/Skorts/Jumpers **may not** be denim, jeans, or sweat pants.
- Sweatshirts and Sweaters **must not** have hoods, and may not be zip-ups.
 - No sleeveless shirts, undershirts must be worn
- Apparel cannot be tied around a student's waist.
- Heels on shoes **may not** exceed ½ inch.
- Specialty shoes (i.e. wheels, web toes, lights, sandals, crocs, high heels, flip flops,) are **not allowed** at school.
- **No** jackets/outerwear may be worn during the school day.
- Extreme hairstyles or body piercing other than ears.
- Make-up and/or lip stick
- Fake Nails
- Jewelry cannot cause a distraction to the learning process.
- Halter or mesh tops, "belly" shirts, spaghetti straps, tank tops or anything too transparent, or that shows underclothing.
- Designer glasses – prescription glasses only.
- Students will not be allowed to wear torn, frayed, or cut clothing.
- Wallet chains and/or oversized chains are not allowed at school or on school buses.

Dress-Down Days

- We ask that parents and guardians monitor slogans and advertisements on clothing; clothing should be neat, clean, and appropriate to age level, and not disruptive to the learning environment.
- Students may not wear hoods.
- No torn, frayed, or cut clothing.
- No halter or mesh tops, "belly" shirts, spaghetti straps, tank tops or anything transparent, or that shows underclothing.

Deviations from the Dress Code:

The school administration will judge the appropriateness of any fad or questionable article of apparel, jewelry, or hairstyle. All students are expected to comply with the dress code. Any student that does not follow the dress code, the following will apply:

- **1st Offense** – Written warning, send to FRC for change of clothing, parent/guardian signature acknowledging infraction and school dress code.
- **2nd Offense** – Phone call home, send to FRC for change of clothing, referral submitted through Infinite Campus
- **3rd Offense** – Parent Conference, student permitted from attending class until uniform guidelines are met, submit referral through Infinite Campus.
- Please remember that personal appearance may not distract from the learning process.
- Guardians are expected to support the uniform dress code.
- Teachers and the FRYSC are responsible for routine checks and referring students.
- If assistance is needed with providing uniforms, please see the Klondike Lane office staff.
- Students who are in violation of the dress code will be given uniform clothing to wear.
- These borrowed uniforms are to be washed and returned to the FRYSC the following day.
